



# 20 Years of Service

The IHSAA and the WIOA would like to honor those officials who have served for 20 years or more as a licensed official in a sport. A special lapel pin has been created and will be presented to those officials.

The qualifications for this award are:

- You must have been licensed by the IHSAA in a single sport for 20 or more years.
- This is effective as of the current sports season. Thus, if this season will be your 20<sup>th</sup> year of officiating in a sport you qualify.
- The license years do not have to be consecutive. For example if you were a licensed official in basketball for 5 years, allowed your license to lapse because you moved out of state, returned to Indiana, renewed your license and officiated for an additional 15 years, you qualify.
